***What courses can I take at Lakeland Community College  
 to meet Cleveland State University's General Education requirements and lower

**CSU Foreign Language Graduation Requirements:**

**University Requirement for High School Graduates in 1987 or Later:**

- The University requires that students pass two (2) years of the same high school foreign language.
- Transfer students may substitute two (2) semesters of the same college-level foreign language for this high school requirement, if they received a C- or higher in both semesters.
- Transfer students who did not complete CSU's foreign language requirement in high school or college must pass two (2) semesters of the same foreign language or take two (2) semesters of American Sign Language and one (1) approved foreign culture course at CSU.
